Location – US Route 50 over Shoal Creek 2 miles east of Jamestown Road.


EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY - The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that the bridge carrying US 50 over Shoal Creek 2 miles east of Jamestown Road in Breese will be reduced to one lane beginning Monday, August 4, 2014 weather permitting. Traffic signals will be in place to direct motorists through the work zone. These bridge lane closures are necessary to perform bridge joint repairs. Please observe caution when travelling through this area. It is estimated that the project will be completed by November 14, 2014. Signing and traffic control devices will be provided to aid motorists.

This work is being done by the Plocher Construction Company of Highland, IL. Steve Putz is the Supervising Field Engineer for the Illinois Department of Transportation in this area. If you have any questions concerning this project, you may contact him at 618/346-3350.
