I-255 in Madison County

LOCATION – I-255 between Horseshoe Lake Road and I-270

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced the following lane restrictions on I-255 between Horseshoe Lake Road and I-270 according to the following schedule, weather permitting:

Sunday, September 28 at 8:00 PM:

- Two southbound right lanes will be closed starting at 8:00 PM
- Southbound traffic will switch to left lane

Monday, September 29 at 8:00 PM


- Two northbound right lanes will be closed starting at 8:00 PM
- Northbound traffic will switch to left lane

These closures are necessary to place the new asphalt surface. The Department asks that motorists be patient, reduce speed, watch for stopped traffic ahead, and use additional caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone.
