I-64 In St. Clair County

LOCATION – I-64 in St. Clair County from the Green Mount Road interchange to the IL 4 interchange. – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces daily and nightly lane restrictions along both eastbound and westbound I-64 between mile markers 16 and 21 beginning Wednesday, April 1, 2015, weather permitting. Lane closures will be utilized to add additional lanes to I-64 and construct a new interchange at Rieder Road. All westbound lanes, west of IL 158, will remain open from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and all westbound lanes, east of IL 158, will remain open from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. All eastbound lanes, west of IL 158, will remain open from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and all eastbound lanes, east of IL 158, will remain open from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. This work is estimated to be completed June, 2017.

Delays should be expected so plan accordingly. The Department asks that motorists be patient, reduce speed, obey all warning signs, and use additional caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone. Please slow down and use extreme caution while driving through all work zones.
