I-64 Eastbound and Westbound from IL158 interchange east to the IL 127 interchange, North of Nashville.

Location – St. Clair, Clinton and Washington Counties

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that on September 17, 2014, road construction will begin on I-64 from IL 158 interchange to IL 127 interchange. This project consists of patching and installing French drains to address and correct deficiencies in the existing pavement. This work is expected to be completed by Sunday, November 30, 2014 weather permitting.
