IL 15 Westbound Lanes between IL 159 and IL 158, St. Clair County, Illinois

The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that only one lane of Illinois Route 15 in St. Clair County will be open in each direction between Illinois 158 and 159 beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, September 12, 2014. A crossover will be utilized for the westbound lane to maintain traffic. These lane reductions are necessary to complete repairs to the existing pavement and should be completed by September 19, 2014, weather permitting.

These repairs to the westbound lanes, west of Illinois Route 159, are to correct damage due to mine subsidence. Corrective actions are being completed by Killian Corporation-Keeley & Sons Construction joint effort.


Travelers are advised to consider alternate routes or allow additional time to travel. Speed limits will be reduced to 35 mph through the crossover. The Department asks that all motorists be patient, reduce speed, and exercise added caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone.
