I-255 in Madison County

LOCATION – I-255 between Horseshoe Lake Road and I-270

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced the following RAMPS WILL BE CLOSED to all traffic according to the following revised schedule, weather permitting:

Thursday, October 16 at 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.:

- o EB I-270 Collector/Distributor Lane CLOSED
- o Ramp from EB I-270 to NB I-255 CLOSED
- o Ramp from SB I-255 to EB I-270 CLOSED (this will stay closed until October 17 at 7:00 p.m.)

Friday, October 17 at 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.:

- o Ramp from SB I-255 to EB I-270 CLOSED (closed beginning at 6:00 a.m. on October 16)
- o Ramp from WB I-270 to SB I-255 CLOSED
- o SB I-255 Collector/Distributor Lane CLOSED

Saturday, October 18 at 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.:

- o Ramp from EB I-270 to SB I-255 CLOSED

Tuesday, October 21 at 7:00 am. through October 22 at 7:00 p.m.:

- o All ramps at the I-255 and IL 162 Interchange CLOSED (these will stay closed until October 22 at 7:00 p.m.)

Wednesday, October 22 through 7:00 p.m.:

- o All ramps at the I-255 and IL 162 Interchange CLOSED (closed beginning October 21 at 7:00 a.m.)


These closures are necessary to resurface the ramps. Signed detours will be in place for each closure. The Department asks that motorists be patient, reduce speed, watch for stopped traffic ahead, and use additional caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone.
