Eastbound and westbound lanes of US Route 50 near US Route 51 in Sandoval to Balridge Lane in Salem.

– The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that eastbound and westbound daytime lane closures on US Route 50 from Sandoval to Baldrige Lane in Salem will begin on Wednesday, September 17, 2014, weather permitting. Intermittent lane restrictions and temporary traffic signals will be utilized during construction in both lanes of US 50. This will allow the contractor to replace drainage structures, patch, and then mill and resurface the roadway. Motorists are urged to use caution, obey all warning signs and allow extra time when traveling through the work zone. This work should be completed by September 9, 2015.
