I-64 in St. Clair County
Mile Markers 19-22

Location - I-64 from 1.3 miles west of IL 158 to 2.1 east of IL 158

The Illinois Department of Transportation lane restrictions will be encountered along both eastbound and westbound I-64 between mile markers 19 and 22 beginning Wednesday, September 10, 2014, weather permitting. Lane closures will be utilized to add additional lanes to I-64 and construct a new interchange at Reider Road. This work is estimated to be completed May 2017.
