***** ROAD CLOSURE *****

Location – IL 106 Approximately 0.5 Miles South of the Scott/Greene County Line

COLLINSVILLE, ILLINOIS – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces a road closure to through traffic on Illinois 106 in Greene County beginning at 7:00 a.m., Monday, August 18, 2014 until 4:00 p.m., Friday, August 22, 2014, weather permitting. The location is approximately 0.5 miles south of the Greene and Scott County Line, between County Line Road and Barrow Road (2700N) in Greene County.

The closure is needed to replace a failed crossroad culvert on IL 106. The Department's Day Labor and District 8 Operations forces will perform the needed culvert and roadway repairs.

A detour, utilizing US 67 and Manchester/Alsey Road, has been marked to enable travelers to circumnavigate the road closure. Additional traffic control devices and directional signage have been deployed to alert motorists of the closure. Travelers are advised to consider alternate routes or allow additional time to travel. The Department asks that all motorists be patient, reduce speed, and exercise added caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone.
