**Location – IL 106 Approximately 0.5 Miles South of the Scott/Greene County Line**

COLLINSVILLE, ILLINOIS – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that the temporary roadway closure on Illinois 106 just south of the Greene and Scott County Line, which began on August 14, 2014, will be opened no later than 4:30 p.m. today, Friday, August 22, 2014. The roadway closure had been extended due to inclement weather. The Department's Day Labor and District 8 Operations forces have been performing the needed roadway repairs.

The Department appreciates the patience of the motoring public during this closure. The Department continues to ask that all motorists be patient, reduce speed, and exercise added caution when traveling near and throughout all work zones.
