### **ROAD CLOSURE** **County Highway 1, Calhoun County, Illinois**

Collinsville, Illinois – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces the closure to thru traffic of County Highway 1 in Calhoun County beginning at 7:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 30, 2015. The road closure is necessary to allow for the replacement of a cross road culvert just north of Royal Landing. This work is expected to be completed and the roadway is anticipated to reopen by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 30, 2015. The Brussels Ferry will remain operating during this closure to provide access to residents and businesses between the road closure and the Illinois River. Stutz Excavating through Calhoun County Highway will be performing the needed culvert replacement.

The Department asks that motorists look for ROAD CLOSED AHEAD signs, reduce speed, watch for slow moving or stopped traffic, and use additional caution when travelling through workzones.
