### I-270 Mississippi River Bridge, near Granite City, Madison County

Collinsville, Illinois – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that daytime lane restrictions will be encountered on the I-270 Mississippi River Bridge, near Granite City. The lane restrictions are needed to perform bridge inspections.

Weather permitting, the lane closures will take place as follows:

Monday, June 1 and Tuesday, June 2, the westbound right lane will be closed from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Wednesday, June 3 and Thursday, June 4, the eastbound right lane will be closed from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

These lane restrictions may result in significant delays to traffic, motorists are encouraged to consider alternate routes.

Traffic control devices will be utilized during these lane restrictions, to assist motorists making their way through the work zone. The Department asks that all motorists be patient, and use additional caution when travelling near and throughout this work zone.
