## **UPDATED Press Release**

### **I-270 Mississippi River Bridge, near Granite City**

Collinsville, Illinois - The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that daytime lane restrictions will be encountered on the I-270 Mississippi River Bridge, near Granite City, Madison County. The lane closures are needed to perform bridge inspections.

Weather permitting, the lane closures will take place as follows:

On June 2 and 3, 2014, the westbound right lane will be closed daily from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

On June 4 and 5, 2014, the eastbound right lane will be closed daily from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

On June 6, 2014, the westbound right lane will be closed from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

It is anticipated the inspections will be completed on June 6, 2014.

Traffic control devices will be utilized during the lane closure, to assist motorists making their way through the work zone. The Department asks that all motorists be patient, reduce speed, and use additional caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone.
