IDOT: Lane Closures on County Line Road at I-55 in Burr Ridge for Reconstruction Project to Begin Jan. 27

Chicago- The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that weather permitting, a reconstruction project on County Line Road over I-55 (Stevenson Expressway) in Burr Ridge will begin Monday, January 27, 2014.

The work will involve pre-stage work with the closure of the inside northbound and southbound lanes of County Line Road for median removal and installation of a crossover. This work is estimated to last approximately 18 days with a SB temporary ramp being installed simultaneously with crossover. Once crossover is completed, stage one construction will switch traffic over to the NB side and demolition of the SB side of the bridge will begin. Traffic will be reduced to one lane SB, one lane NB and one auxiliary lane NB. In addition, there will be some shoulder closures on I-55.

This project will be completed in two stages with changeable message signs in place to alert motorists to traffic changes.

Drivers should expect lengthy delays and urged to pay close attention to the signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, be on the alert for workers and equipment and be prepared to stop.
