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## **IDOT: Bridge Deck Replacement on IL RT 43 Over US RT 41 in Park City to Begin March 3**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that weather and temperature permitting, a bridge deck replacement project on northbound IL Route 43 over southbound US Route 41 is scheduled to begin Monday, March 3, 2014.

In order to complete the work, NB IL RT 43 will be closed, along with the bridge structure carrying NB IL RT 43 over SB US Route 41 until August 15, 2014.

The scope of work includes bridge deck removal & replacement, milling & resurfacing, guard rail replacement and other incidental repairs.

The detour route for the NB direction will be in place beginning at the intersection of IL RT 43 & IL RT 137 directing traffic on EB IL 137 to NB US 41 to end just North of IL 120.

For NB RT 41 and RT 43 on EB RT 120, a detour will be in place at the ramp to NB RT 41 directing traffic to continue EB on RT 120 to NB 131 to EB RT 132 to end at RT 41.

Motorists can expect delays during times when the lane closures are in effect and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signing in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
