IDOT: Ramp/Lane Closures on 111th Street Exit Ramp & 115th Street for Crash Barrel Repairs on I-94 (Bishop Ford Expressway) Saturday

Chicago- The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that weather permitting, repairs to crash barrels on I-94 (Bishop Ford Expressway) northbound from 115th Street to 111th Street will occur Saturday morning, March 15, 2014.

In order to complete the work, it is necessary to close the 111th Street exit ramp in conjunction with the right lane from 115th Street to 111th Street from midnight to 5 a.m. Saturday morning. The far two left lanes will remain open to the motoring public.

Motorists can expect significant delays during times when the lane closures are in effect and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signing in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
