Benefits

The State of Illinois offers a competitive benefits program for IDOT employees.

Healthcare

The state offers several health plan options, which include prescription benefits. Other benefits include vision, dental, life insurance, and behavioral health coverage. Employees may choose between several managed care plans, an open-access plan, and a preferred provider option.



Retirement

After serving a six-month qualifying period, employees become a member of the State Employees' Retirement System (SERS). Contributions from wages, through payroll deduction are automatically credited to your retirement account. SERS is funded by contributions from state agencies, including IDOT. In order to be eligible for a pension, employees must have service credit of at least eight years. In addition to retirement benefits, as a member of SERS employees are eligible for disability benefits as well as survivor and death benefits.

Workplace

IDOT employees may also be eligible for other benefits such as holidays, annual leave and sick leave. The department also offers tuition reimbursement to encourage employees to advance their education.
