This expenditure is justified as:

- An emergency involving public health.
- An emergency involving public safety.
- Necessary to protect State property from further loss or damage.
- Necessary to prevent or minimize serious disruption in State services.
- Necessary to insure integrity of State records.
- Quick purchase as provided by Section 20-30 (d) of the Illinois Procurement Code.

The conditions and circumstances requiring this emergency expenditure are:

A box culvert carrying field drainage under US 45 has failed requiring traffic to be detoured to prevent further damage and to protect public safety. The box is located 1.5 miles north of US 24 near Gilman in Iroquois County.

Bids were solicited from three local contractors, with Iroquois Paving Corporation having the lowest bid of \$43,250.00. The urgency of the box culvert replacement had the contractors bidding on pre-final plans for the Department to make the selection. To complete the project a contingent (109.04) amount will be added to the contract. The total value of the affidavit and the contract will be \$75,000.00.

The contractor's bids are as follows:

- Iroquois Paving Corporation - \$43,250.00
- Tobey's Construction - \$45,210.00
- Kankakee Valley Construction - No Bid
