- Quick purchase as provided by Section 20-30 (d) of the Illinois Procurement Code.

The conditions and circumstances requiring this emergency expenditure are:

The excessive rains have caused a 12" filed tile running under IL 26 to fail creating a large void under the north bound lane of IL 26. Currently the north bound lane is closed with traffic redirected into the left turn lane. Continued rains and the subsequent water flowing through the field tile are causing further erosion of the pavement structure.

This is located on IL 26 approximately 2.5 miles north of I-80.

Expedited plans were developed and circulated to three contractors with the following results.
