**PEORIA** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces lane closures due to work on the bridges carrying I-74 over US 150 (Jackson Street) in Morton this weekend.

The work will consist of removal of a portion of each bridge and will require the closure of the left lane of eastbound and westbound I-74 from Friday, February 28<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m. until Monday, March 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30 a.m.

In addition, Jackson Street under I-74 will be closed Sunday, March 2<sup>nd</sup> from 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. to safely remove the section of bridge at that location. During this time, US 150 traffic will be routed via a marked detour on Morton Avenue, Courtland Street, and Veterans Road.

The overall project is the complete reconstruction of I-74 from Pleasant Hill Road to Morton Avenue in Tazewell County. The project is expected to be completed in 2015.
