The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is conducting a study of I-270 from the Riverview Drive interchange in St. Louis, Missouri to Illinois Route 157 in Madison County, Illinois. Called the Illinois I-270 Preliminary Engineering Study, the goal for the first phase of this study is to investigate how to address traffic growth while relieving congestion and improving safety along the route. Potential alternatives to the interchange of I-270/IL 111 will also be presented, as this has recently been funded through the Illinois Competitive Freight Program.
