## LEGAL PUBLIC NOTICE CITY OF PERU

The City of Peru is planning to extend Unytle Drive from Donlar Avenue to Plank Road and to sponsor a project with Peru Industrial Railroad to add a railroad siding between Plank Road and Donlar Avenue and to extend an existing railroad siding west of Plank Road. The roadway project will include a concrete roadway with asphalt shoulders. This project is required to be included in the IDOT Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) document. The estimated improvement cost of the roadway project which includes construction, utility relocation, and right-of-way acquisitions, is \$1,805,000 of which \$1,093,000 will come from Federal Competitive Freight Program funds. The remaining balance shall be paid by a combination of local and Motor Fuel Tax funds. The estimated improvement cost for the railroad project, which includes design, engineering, and construction, is \$2,602,000 of which \$1,561,000 will come from Federal Competitive Freight Program funds. The remaining balance shall be paid by the railroad. The City of Peru invites the public to comment. Comments must be in writing and will be accepted until 4:00 p.m. on February 18, 2019 at City Hall, 1901 Fourth St., Peru, Illinois 61354.
