The Macoupin County Highway Department has received Federal Surface Transportation funding to improve the curves on FAS 731, Nine Mile Road, 3 miles east of Modesto. The \$1,922,000 project of which \$1,167,000 are federal Highway Safety Improvement Program funds, \$499,200 of federal Surface Transportation Rural funds and \$278,800 in local matching funds includes reconstruction of the intersections with Campbell Road and Otten Road, upgrading the north curve to current design criteria and removal and replacement of the south curve with a T-intersection. An aggregate base, oil and chip surface, grading, new culverts and new signing are part of the improvements. This project is required to be included in the IDOT Surface Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) document. The Macoupin County Highway Department invites the public to comment on the IDOT STIP and the Project.
