CIRCULAR LETTER 2021-04

REBUILD ILLINOIS BOND GRANTS TO LOCAL PUBLIC AGENCIES - FUND IMPLEMENTATION (INFORMATION EXCHANGE) & THIRD INSTALLMENT ISSUANCE

COUNTY ENGINEERS / SUPERINTENDENTS OF HIGHWAYS / MUNICIPAL ENGINEERS / DIRECTORS OF PUBLIC WORKS / MAYORS / METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATIONS – DIRECTORS / TOWNSHIP HIGHWAY COMMISSIONERS / CONSULTING ENGINEERS

This Circular Letter is issued for the purposes of;

- Providing additional information, support, and assistance by the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) to Local Public Agencies (LPA) regarding the planning, employment, implementation, policies and procedures of the REBUILD Illinois (RBI) grants program available on bondable projects;
- 2) Planning, understanding, and communicating with IDOT the intent of how each LPA will employ their RBI allotment on a project-by-project basis, via a non-committal "Information Exchange"; and
- 3) Update the LPA on their Total Grant Estimates, prior to the issuance of the planned third (3rd) RBI installment.

LPA's are strongly encouraged to participate in this process, and to identify capital bondable projects via the "Information Exchange Process" below. Please note that all grants in the RBI Program shall be authorized by July 1, 2025 and identifying eligible projects in a timely manner will provide ample time for planning and executing projects prior to that deadline.

HISTORY & BACKGROUND

On June 28, 2019 Governor Pritzker signed the REBUILD ILLINOIS Capital Plan to fund transportation projects and improvements, along with many other investments. The first (1st) of these critical investments for \$250 Million was awarded and distributed in May 2020. The second (2nd) of these \$250 Million investments was awarded and distributed in July 2020.

With moving into calendar year 2021, IDOT will soon provide LPA's with the third (3rd) installment of the \$1.5 billion grant program from the local government component of the RBI capital bill program. As with the first (1st) and second (2nd) installments, this third (3rd) installment will again consist of \$250 million that will be distributed based on the regular Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) formula. As with the previous issuances, this \$250 million installment of funds are not MFT distributions, rather, they are grants made from bond sale proceeds that must be deposited into the LPA MFT account and tracked separately as RBI spends.

ALLOTMENT AMOUNT RESOURCE

INFORMATION EXCHANGE PROCESS

To ease and expedite the exchange of information, each LPA needs to complete an online form for <u>each intended project</u> that will, or is planned, to employ RBI funds. Please note that for each project submitted, the LPA will receive a verification email of submission and content for their information and verification.

- Please remain aware of the deadlines for eligibility for usage and implementation of the RBI Program as stated within this Circular Letter 2021-04, above.


