

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Illinois Technology Transfer Center Training Program



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Online Enrollment

Please register online for all courses here.

The courses listed on the following pages constitute the Technology Transfer Training Program and are scheduled to be presented on the dates and locations indicated. These classes are all tuition-free, unless otherwise noted. Travel, meals and lodging expenses are always the responsibility of the student.

ENROLLMENT

We invite your agency to enroll students in the classes you desire by completing our online <u>enrollment form</u>.

It is important that you enroll early. Some classes fill up quickly, and we may not be able to schedule additional classes. In cases of excess enrollment, some attendance restrictions will be imposed. In cases of insufficient enrollment, classes may be cancelled. Enrollment in a class will be handled in accordance.

The contact person listed on the online enrollment form will receive an email approximately 24-48 hours prior to the class confirming their registration and providing the classroom/location information. If the class fills up, the applicant will be notified by email that they have been placed on a waiting list and will be contacted if there are cancellations.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If a student is unable to attend, it is the agency's responsibility to cancel at least 24 hours prior to the class. Frequent no shows may result in your agency receiving lower priority in future enrollments.

CONSULTANT POLICY

Enrollment for consultants will be allowed in all Technology Transfer training classes except for local agency only classes. Due to the popularity of our classes, we must limit each consulting firm to a maximum of four attendees per class.

CERTIFICATES

A certificate of completion will be awarded to students who successfully complete the final examination for the class. In classes where final exams are not given, a certificate of attendance will be awarded. The majority of T2 classes meet the requirements for Professional Development Hours. The number of PDHs given per class can be found with the course description; however, it is the student's responsibility to ensure that the course meets the continuing education requirements of their license.

NOTE: CHANGES TO SCHEDULING OF FLAGGER TRAININGS

IDOT recommends retraining flaggers every three years. Flaggers who have not been trained in the last three years should be scheduled for training or use the online version of Flagger Safety training.

Flagger training sessions are scheduled regionally throughout the state. Additional trainings may be added and announced monthly from the T2 email subscription service. However, our capacity to add classes is limited. If your agency has a training room that is computer/projector accessible, will seat at least 50 participants and is open to employees from other agencies, please email Stephanie Stoverink or Barry Kent to be considered for a class onsite at your location.

The U.S. Department of Labor and the Illinois Department of Labor have not specifically defined flagging as a hazardous job. However, the Illinois Department of Transportation recognizes that certain hazards and risks come with the job. Therefore, registration for and participation in flagger training classes and activities are limited to participants aged 18 and up.

2023 Fall Training Course Descriptions

Flagger Training

Overview: This class provides training to local agency personnel for their day labor and maintenance activities. It meets requirements established by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration.

Prerequisites: This course is available to local agency highway personnel holding a valid driver's license or an Illinois identification card from the Secretary of State.

Topics Covered: Traffic control devices, the flagger's role in work zone safety, Illinois laws and responsibilities, and flagging procedures.

Illinois Statutes and Rules for Professional Engineering

Overview: This meets the required new IDFPR rules for PDH course requirements.

Repairing Pipe Culverts with Pipe Liners

Overview: This course will provide guidance for repair of pipe culverts using one of four different types of pipe liners currently supported by IDOT policy. An overview of each liner type, including applicability, construction requirements, and plan and specification requirements, will be provided.

Snow and Ice Control Training

Overview: The course provides training to local agency personnel for their winter snow and ice operations.

Topics Covered: Planning for snow and ice operations, weather information sources, equipment, snow and ice chemicals, chloride and the environment, level of service, and post-storm activities.

Plant Mix Asphalt: Design, Construction, Maintenance and Rehabilitation

Overview: Participants will learn about: Proper pavement design procedures including Modified AASHTO and M-E Design of flexible pavements; plant mix design procedures including volumetric properties, performance criteria and additives; importance of proper construction techniques, equipment and inspection; effective use of maintenance treatments; and rehabilitation techniques for existing pavements. Plant tour in the afternoon.

Smart Roadway Lighting Solutions/ Energy Cost Savings & Utility Rebates with Smart LED Street Lights and Controls

Overview: This course will focus on why Smart LED lighting is a financially and environmentally sound choice for municipalities and communities. Smart LED roadway lighting, sensors and controls provide energy cost savings through efficient lighting, reduced maintenance and utility rebates.

PASER

Overview: This course is intended to assist local officials in understanding and rating the surface condition of asphalt, concrete, sealcoat and gravel pavements. It will describe types of defects and provides a simple system to visually rate pavement conditions. It also will present how to use the ratings to assist in planning and budgeting. The course will consist of both classroom lecture and practicing rating roads in the field.
