

Passenger Rail in Illinois



- Amtrak operates 56 daily trains in and through Illinois.
- Amtrak serves nearly 5 million riders at Illinois stations.
- Illinois subsidizes 30 statesponsored trains that provide service in 4 regional corridors, with 2 million annual riders.





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Chicago - St. Louis Lincoln Service

- 4 daily round trips
- Chicago Quincy IL Zephyr/Carl Sandburg
 - 2 daily round trips
- Chicago Carbondale Illini/Saluki
 - 2 daily round trips
- Chicago Milwaukee *Hiawatha Service* (jointly supported with WisDOT)
 - 7 daily round trips (6 on Sundays)

HSR Corridor Accomplishments

- Installation of new rail, concrete ties and related components
- Upgrades made to bridges and culverts, drainage and signaling systems
- New sidings and sections of double track
- Major safety upgrades at crossings with four-quadrant gates and loop detectors
- New stations open in Joliet, Dwight, Pontiac, Carlinville, and Alton. Renovated station in Lincoln. Improvements to station in Springfield.


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Chicago to St. Louis High Speed Rail Project

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- > 90 mph schedule went into effect December 2021.
- IDOT continues to work with our partners (Federal Railroad Administration, Union Pacific Railroad, Amtrak) on the implementation of110 mph service on the Chicago to St. Louis corridors
- We expect 110 mph service will be initiated in Summer 2023.
- Remaining infrastructure improvements near Midewin in environmental process.





'Rebuild Illinois' Capital Plan

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- \$45B capital plan for infrastructure, state facilities, education, and environmental projects
- Passed by IL General Assembly and signed into law by Gov. Pritzker in June 2019.

Rail highlights:

- Additional \$225M for Chicago-Quad Cities service expansion project
- \$275M to reinitiate Chicago-Rockford service expansion project
- > \$100M for Chicago-Carbondale corridor improvements
- > \$122M for Springfield 10th St Improvement project
- > \$400M for the Chicago CREATE program





Other Passenger Rail Projects in Illinois

- » Chicago to Quad Cities Rail Project (IDOT lead)
- » Chicago to Rockford Rail Project (IDOT)
- » Chicago to Carbondale Rail Improvements Project (IDOT)
- » Chicago to Peoria Rail Project (Peoria)
- » Springfield 10th Street Improvement Project (Springfield)





- » 88 Siemens Venture cars ordered
 - 54 coach cars 70 seats
 - 17 business/coach cars 36 business class seats and 16 coach class seats.
 - 17 café/coach cars 30 seats
- » 68 cars have been delivered to IDOT
 - 54 coach cars & 14 business/coach cars
 - 44 fully accepted and able to be in revenue service
- » Café/coach cars to begin to be delivered in 2023.





- » Improved car amenities
 - Triple capacity for bicycle storage
 - Double capacity for business class passengers
 - Bright, modern, fully accessible lavatories
 - ADA wide aisles
 - Free Wi-Fi with antennas in each car






