## **Bridge Repairs on Harlem Avenue over the Cal-Sag Channel**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that daily lane closures will take place on the bridge that carries Harlem Avenue (Illinois 43) over the Cal-Sag Channel, in Palos Heights and Worth, for safety improvements, beginning, weather permitting, Wednesday, June 1. The closures are necessary to perform bridge repairs and bridge painting.

In order to complete the work, daily lane closures will take place on Harlem Avenue over the Cal-Sag Channel. Traffic will be reduced to one lane with flaggers. The closure times will exclude peak traffic volume hours from 7-9 a.m. and 4-6 p.m.

The project is expected to be completed in Summer 2016.

Motorists can expect delays and are advised to seek alternate routes. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
