Intersection Improvement on Milwaukee Avenue at Golf Road and Greenwood Avenue

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that work to improve the intersections of Milwaukee Avenue (Illinois 21) at Golf Road (Illinois 58) and Milwaukee Avenue (Illinois 21) at Greenwood Avenue, in Niles and Glenview, will begin, weather permitting, Thursday, Feb. 11.

The project will modernize traffic signals, install signalized pedestrian crosswalks and construct sidewalk ramps in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

Daytime lane closures will be necessary to complete the work. The project is scheduled for completion in Summer 2016.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
