## **Pre-Stage Work on Illinois 47 at Burlington Road for Intersection Improvement Project**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that pre-stage work will take place to improve the intersection of Illinois 47 and Burlington Road, in Kane County, beginning, weather permitting, Friday, April 8. The pre-stage work will require a full closure of Illinois 47 at Burlington Road.

In order to complete the work, Illinois 47 will be closed at Burlington Road from 10 p.m. Friday, April 8, until 4 a.m. Monday, April 11. A detour will direct traffic on northbound Illinois 47 to go east on Illinois 64 to Burlington Road. Drivers should travel northwest on Burlington Road to Dittman Road, north to Plato Road and west to meet back on Illinois 47. Southbound traffic on Illinois 47 will take the reverse route.

The scope of the project includes reconstruction of the four-way stop into a single-lane roundabout intersection. It also will reconstruct pavement and improve roadway lighting, drainage structures and signing.

For the duration of the project, Burlington Road will be closed and Illinois 47 will maintain one lane in each direction. The project is expected to be completed in Fall 2016.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
