Safety Improvement Project Resumes along Interstate 57 from U.S. 30 to Interstate 80

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that a safety improvement project will resume along Interstate 57 from south of Lincoln Highway (U.S. 30) to north of Interstate 80, in Country Club Hills and Matteson, beginning, weather permitting, the evening of Tuesday, April 26.

In order to complete the work, temporary, nightly lane closures will take place at various locations along Interstate 57. Interstate 80 also will have a nightly closure near Central Avenue, when necessary.

The scope of the project consists of asphalt resurfacing, installation of milling shoulder rumble strips, guardrails and removal and replacement of thermoplastic pavement markings.

The project is expected to be completed in Spring 2016.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
