Ottawa, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that the IL 23-Norfolk Southern Railway Company grade crossing in Streator will be closed on Monday, November 7, 2016. IL 23 will be closed for approximately seven days to allow the Norfolk Southern Railway Company to repair their crossing. IL 23 traffic will proceed as follows:

IL 23 northbound traffic will proceed east on Bronson Street to Shabbona Street; thence north on Shabbona Street to Fourth Street; thence west on Fourth Street back to IL 23.

IL 23 southbound traffic will proceed east on Fourth Street to Baker Street; thence south on Baker Street to First Street; thence west on First Street back to IL 23.

Baker Street will be a one way street for southbound traffic only from Fourth Street to First Street.

Motorists are urged to use caution and expect delays while traveling the detour route.
