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Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, construction work on US 30 west of Rock Falls will begin on Tuesday, July 5, 2016. Martin & Company Excavating will be starting the \$1.7 million project to make repairs to the bridge carrying US 30 over the Rock River two miles west of Rock Falls.

The project includes making concrete repairs to the bridge deck, painting the steel beams, replacing expansion joints and placing a new wearing surface on the structure. Because the expansion joints extend across both lanes of the bridge, the roadway needs to be closed to make the repairs. US 30 traffic will be detoured around the work area on I-88.

The project is scheduled to be completed by the end of October. Motorists should be aware of the road closure and follow the detour or plan alternative routes if traveling west from Rock Falls.

Please slow down and use extreme caution while driving through all work zones.

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
