Work Set to Resume on I-74 and I-155 near Morton

PEORIA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work will resume Friday, April 1 on I-74 from I-474 to Main St. and on I-155 from Birchwood Ave. to I-74 in Morton.

The traffic pattern on eastbound I-74 at the Morton Ave. (Exit 102) interchange will change April 1. Traffic in the right lane of eastbound I-74 will be required to exit to Morton Ave. Through traffic will use the left lane of eastbound I-74. This traffic pattern will remain in effect until July, while construction of eastbound I-74 lanes is completed.

Work zone speed limits will be set to 45 mph along I-74 and I-155 in the vicinity of this project, starting April 1.

The overall project is the complete reconstruction of I-74 from Pleasant Hill Rd. to Morton Ave. in Tazewell County. The project is expected to be completed by Fall 2016.
