Brownstown Interchange Ramp Closure

Entrance and exit ramps to be closed at mile post 68 on
October 10, 2016 and October 11, 2016

The Illinois Department of Transportation has announced that the Brownstown (U.S. 40) interchange with I-70 will be closed on Monday, October 10, 2016 and Tuesday, October 11, 2016 to complete HMA resurfacing. The ramps will be closed on Monday at 7:00 a.m. and re-opened by 4:00 p.m. the same day. The ramps will be closed the following day to complete work on the ramps using the same schedule. This work is in conjunction with the interstate resurfacing from the Brownstown interchange to the St. Elmo interchange.
