## **PRESS RELEASE**

Madison County

Location – I-70 near Highland

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced there will be intermittent lane closures in each direction on I-70 from Prairie Road (mile post 26) to Baumann Road (mile post 33) near Highland beginning Monday, November 14, 2016, weather permitting. These lane restrictions will be necessary to make repairs to the pavement. Traffic will be maintained utilizing message boards, flaggers, signs and other traffic control devices. This work is expected to be completed by the end of December 2016.

All lanes will be open to peak hour traffic during the following times:

- Eastbound I-70: Monday through Thursday - 3:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M.
- Westbound I-70: Monday through Friday - 6:00 A.M. to 8:00 A.M.
- Eastbound and Westbound I-70: Fridays - 12:00 P.M. to 12:00 A.M.
