## **U.S. 45/52 resurfacing begins Nov. 2** *From Bourbonnais to Kankakee*

**KANKAKEE** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that resurfacing of U.S. 45/52 between Armour Road in Bourbonnais and Court Street (Illinois 17) in Kankakee begins Nov. 2.

The project will proceed with the following schedule:

- 9 a.m. Nov. 2 at Armour Road in the southbound lanes.
- 7 a.m. Nov. 3 at Court Street in the northbound lanes.
- 9 a.m. Nov. 4 to finish the southbound lanes.
- 7 a.m. Nov. 5 to finish the northbound lanes.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,300 miles of highway and 8.4 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Year One included approximately \$2.7 billion of improvements statewide on 1,706 miles of highway, 128 bridges and 228 additional safety improvements.
