Work on I-57 at U.S. 150 resumes Oct. 12

CHAMPAIGN – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that nighttime work on Interstate 57 at Bloomington Road (U.S. 150), just south of the I-74 junction, resumes Oct. 12.

The project involves installing new beams on the bridge that carries U.S. 150 over I-57, with the following closures taking place between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. each night. On Oct. 12, the right lane of southbound I-57 will be closed, and periodic closures of U.S. 150 of about 15 minutes each will be necessary to unload the beams. On Oct. 13, the left southbound lane will be closed.

Full closures of northbound I-57 will be necessary on Oct. 13-14, with a detour posted, and single lane closures in both directions on Oct. 15 and Oct. 18.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,300 miles of highway and 8.4 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Year One included approximately \$2.7 billion of improvements statewide on 1,706 miles of highway, 128 bridges and 228 additional safety improvements.
