## Work at Willow/Pfingsten intersection begins this week

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that beginning this week, improvements to the intersection of Willow and Pfingsten roads, in Glenview, will require daytime lane closures with flaggers.

The project will resurface and widen the intersection to allow for new right-turn lanes on Willow Road, install modernized traffic signals and construct new ADA-compliant sidewalk ramps. Work is expected to be completed in August.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,300 miles of highway and 8.4 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Year One included approximately \$2.7 billion of improvements statewide on 1,706 miles of highway, 128 bridges and 228 additional safety improvements.
