US 50 from West of Frogtown Road to West of IL 127 in Clinton County

Carlyle – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that US 50 will have intermittent lane restrictions from 0.3 mile west of Frogtown Road near Breese to 0.1 mile west of IL 127 in Carlyle beginning on Monday, April 12, 2021, weather permitting. Traffic in each direction will be maintained using flaggers. These restrictions are necessary to place a new bituminous surface treatment and new pavement markings. This work is expected to be completed by the end of July 2021.

Drivers should expect delays and are asked to consider using alternate routes. Drivers are urged to reduce speed, be alert for changing conditions, obey all construction signage, and refrain from using mobile devices while approaching and traveling through the work zone.

The contractor on this project is Asphalt Stone Company of Jacksonville, IL.
