*HOT MIX ASPHALT RESURFACING*  
*IL 169*  
*PULASKI-MASSAC COUNTIES*

The Illinois Department of Transportation would like to alert motorists traveling on IL 169 in Pulaski and Massac Counties of an upcoming LANE REDUCTIONS.

Beginning Wednesday, April 21, 2021, weather permitting, there will be road construction work on IL 169 that will require lane reductions. Work includes patching, surface removal, hot mix asphalt surface course, hot mix asphalt shoulders, and pavement markings along IL 169 from IL 37 in Pulaski County to US 45 in Massac County. Motorists should reduce speed, be alert to equipment and workers and use extreme caution when traveling through this area. Work is expected to be completed July 2, 2021.
