I-74/280 pavement patching in Rock Island County to begin April 26

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that weather permitting, pavement patching work in the eastbound lanes of Interstates 74 and 280 near Mosquito Creek in Rock Island County will begin on Monday, April 26, 2021. The creek is located near mile marker 10, about 3.5 miles west of Interstate 80. The repairs will require lane closures.

G.M. Sipes Construction Inc. of Rushville is the contractor for the \$115,525 project, which is expected to be completed in early May.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
