## U.S. 150 work in St. Joe, Ogden begins July 12

**ST. JOSEPH** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that construction on U.S. 150 in St. Joseph and Ogden begins July 12.

The project involves resurfacing the intersections of U.S. 150 (Warren Street) and Main Street in St. Joseph and U.S. 150 (Lincoln Avenue) and Illinois 49 (Market Street) in Ogden. One-way traffic through the intersections will be controlled by flaggers during the work, which is expected to last two to three days.

Long delays are possible, and motorists are encouraged to find alternate routes.

Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,500 miles of highway and 9 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Two included approximately \$5.2 billion of improvements statewide on 3,020 miles of highway, 270 bridges and 428 additional safety improvements.
