St. Joseph Road to close June 16 *Bridge reconstruction near Sidney*

SIDNEY – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that St. Joseph Road (Champaign County Highway 12) over the Salt Fork Vermilion River, just north of Sidney, will close June 16.

The closure is necessary to reconstruct the bridge over Salt Fork and is expected to last through the end of November.

To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,300 miles of highway and 8.4 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Year One included approximately \$2.7 billion of improvements statewide on 1,706 miles of highway, 128 bridges and 228 additional safety improvements.
