Kinlou Road 0.1 Mile West of the Clay County Line in Marion County

Kinmundy – The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that Kinlou Road 0.1 mile west of the Clay County Line will be closed to all traffic beginning Tuesday, July 6, 2021, weather permitting. This work is necessary to replace the existing structure over a tributary to Skillet Fork Creek. Kinlou Road is expected to be reopened in early August 2021.

Motorists will need to find an alternate route during this closure. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to construction signage and watch for changing conditions, obey the posted speed limits, and refrain from using mobile devices.
