IL 127 from the Bond County Line to 0.2 Mile North of Williams Road North of Carlyle

Carlyle – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that IL 127 from the Bond County Line to 0.2 mile north of Williams Road north of Carlyle will be intermittently restricted to one lane beginning Tuesday, July 6, 2021, weather permitting. This work will take place daily between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM. Traffic in each direction will be maintained using flaggers. This work is necessary to complete pavement repairs and is expected to be completed by late July 2021.

Motorists should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

The contractor on this project is Freehill Asphalt, Inc. of Watseka, Illinois.
