## **ROAD CLOSURE**

### ***Emergency Pavement Patching***

### ***I-24 Eastbound***

### ***Massac County***

**CARBONDALE**-The Illinois Department of Transportation is alerting motorists traveling on eastbound Interstate 24 in Massac County of an upcoming road closure for two nights (only) beginning at 8 p.m. Tuesday, June 22, and opened by 7 a.m. Wednesday, June 23, and closed again at 8 p.m. Wednesday, June 23 and opened by 7 a.m. Thursday, June 24, weather permitting.

Interstate 24 will be closed in the eastbound lanes nightly from milepost 16 to milepost 37.

The closure is necessary to facilitate emergency pavement patching at various locations.

Eastbound I-24 should utilize Illinois 146 to Illinois 145, then Illinois 145 to the US 45/I-24 Metropolis Interchange.

Please use alternate routes, reduce speed, be alert to equipment and workers and use extreme caution while traveling through all work zones.
