Resurfacing of Illinois 64 begins July 7

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, resurfacing on Illinois 64 in Ogle County will begin on Wednesday, July 7, 2021. The project limits are from US 52 to Illinois 26.

Daily lane closures with flaggers will be utilized and drivers should be prepared to stop when directed within the work zone. Access to residences and businesses within the work zone will be maintained throughout construction. Helm Civil of Freeport is the contractor of the \$1,497,762 project, which is expected to be completed by August 8, 2021.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve 2,779 miles of highway and 7.9 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Year One included approximately \$2.7 billion of improvements statewide on 1,706 miles of highway, 128 bridges and 228 additional safety improvements.
