## Bridge repairs over U.S. 34 in Galesburg begin April 5

**GALESBURG** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that construction on the Farnham Street bridge over westbound U.S. 34 in Galesburg begins April 5.

The project involves straightening and replacing steel girders on the bridge, located a half-mile west of the Interstate 74/U.S. 34 interchange, and will require intermittent lane closures on westbound U.S. 34 as well as I-74 off-ramps to westbound U.S. 34. Detours will be posted when necessary. Work is expected to be complete in May.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,300 miles of highway and 8.4 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Year One included approximately \$2.7 billion of improvements statewide on 1,706 miles of highway, 128 bridges and 228 additional safety improvements.
