## I-55 lane closures at Madison Street begin Tuesday

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that repairs to the bridge carrying Interstate 55 over Madison Street, in Burr Ridge, will begin, weather permitting, Tuesday, June 1.

At least three lanes in each direction on I-55 will be maintained throughout the project. Motorists should expect lane shifts and occasional overnight lane and ramp closures. Madison Street will remain open in each direction with lane width reduced to 11 feet.

The project, which consists of a bridge deck overlay with joint replacement, new guardrail and structural steel repairs, is expected to be completed in late August.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve 2,779 miles of highway and 7.9 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Year One included approximately \$2.7 billion of improvements statewide on 1,706 miles of highway, 128 bridges and 228 additional safety improvements.
