## **US 50 in Clinton County**

**Breese** – The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that US 50 in Clinton County from 0.3 mile west of St. Rose Road to 0.3 mile west of Frogtown Road will be intermittently restricted to one lane beginning Monday, May 17, 2021, weather permitting. This work will take place daily between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM. Traffic will be maintained using flaggers. This work is necessary to complete pavement repairs and asphalt resurfacing. Work is expected to be completed by early July 2021.

Motorists should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to construction signage and watch for changing conditions, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment while approaching and traveling through the work zone.
